## **Judge Of All The Earth**

Genesis 18:16-33

## **Discussion Questions**

What comes to your mind when you think about the concepts of “righteousness” and “justice”? Why can these be difficult truths to accept as they relate to the Lord? What did you learn about the righteousness and justice of God from this passage?

Why did God reveal His plans of judgment to Abraham (vv. 17-21)? Why is the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah important for God’s people as we pursue the way of the Lord? How was Sodom’s sin described in this passage and how are God’s people to be different (Ezek. 16:49-50)? How does this relate to the role of parents with their children (v. 19)?

How is God’s wrath different than our normal understanding of human anger and wrath? How does this passage describe His judgment (vv. 20-21)? What should be our response when we understand the perfection of God’s justice and wrath?

What do we learn from Abraham’s plea to the Lord (vv. 22-33)? What does this interaction reveal about the compassion of God and the compassion of His people? What assurance did Abraham have while interceding for the righteous (v. 25)? How is God’s justice an anchor for believers as we seek to persevere?
