Discussion Questions

What did you learn about God from this passage? Are there any attributes of God that make you uncomfortable? Why? In what ways are you encouraged by what this passage reveals about the Lord?

What does Pharaoh's response to Yahweh throughout Exodus reveal about the sinful nature of mankind (8:8, 28; 9:27-28; 10:17; 12:32)? What are some examples of responses to sin that don't necessarily demonstrate true repentance?

Why does this passage spend so much time on the details of Pharaoh's military force? How do you usually respond to the arrogance and anger of the world? How does having God's perspective help in processing the evil all around us?

What was Israel's response when they were surrounded by Pharaoh and the Egyptians? Are there any unhealthy or sinful habits you are tempted to return to when faced with difficulties? How do you think God wants you to deal with these habits?

What does Moses command of Israel in response to their fear? Do you have trouble "standing still" in the midst of difficulties? Why is this sometimes the right response?
