## **Discussion Questions**

What struggles or questions do you have about men's and women's roles in the church? How much do you think the culture has influenced your view on men and women? Was this passage surprising to you in any ways?

What sins does Paul instruct believers to avoid in vv. 8-10? Why does he address particular sins for men and then for women? What virtues should characterize God's people in contrast to the sins mentioned?

Would you characterize yourself as a learner? Why or why not? Why is it important to understand we assemble for corporate worship to learn? Is there anything that hinders your pursuit of learning when gathering for church?

How would you summarize Paul's instruction in vv. 11-12? Why are his reasons in vv. 13-14 important to his argument? How would you respond if someone said these verses don't apply today?

If you are a man, why does the brunt of responsibility in the discussion of roles and responsibilities fall on you? If you are woman, can you list some of the many ways in which you can serve in the body of Christ?
