Dead To Sin, Alive To God

Romans 6:1-4

Discussion Questions

How would you define sanctification? What questions have you had about this process of growing in holiness?

What are some of the errors that can result from a misunderstanding of grace and works? Why is it important to understand that believers grow through grace? Why is it wrong to think that grace enables sinners?

Can a Christian live their whole life characterized by habitual sin? Why or why not? How would Paul respond to this question in this passage?

What does it mean to be “dead to sin” (v. 2)? Does it mean that we no longer sin at all? Why or why not? How does Paul further describe what it means to be dead to sin in this passage (vv. 6, 7, 11-12, 14)? Why should this truth encourage you as a believer?

Why does Paul use baptism to describe that we are dead to sin? What does baptism symbolize? Why is participation in the act of water baptism important for each and every believer?

Why is it important to understand what happened “in Christ” at one’s conversion? What is God’s purpose for believers having been made alive in Jesus (v. 4)? Does your life reflect a desire to live out this purpose?
